


Flow of Funding



OSF Programming

Academics

Innovative Classroom Grants, Lego/Robotics clubs, Enhance 7-8th grade S.T.E.M., Upgrade K-4 language arts reading rooms, Pre-Kindergarten literacy

Arts

Expand Art in Elementary, Clay High School Choir, Limelighters and Band support that exceeds district budget.

Athletics

Assist with needs of junior and high school athletic programs that exceed district budget.

Endowment

The Endowment fund is a financial asset, in the form of donations made to OSF, consisting of investment funds.

OSF's Endowment is designed to keep the principal amount intact while using the investment income from dividends for charitable efforts.

OSF's Endowment doesn't generate enough income annually yet to fund yearly initiatives.

After Endowment assets reach \$500k, interest will be used to fund classroom grants.

Your investment in the Endowment is in perpetuity, meaning the principal is never spent.
